Maasai Mara is most famous for the annual Great Wildebeest Migration, a massive movement of over a million wildebeest and zebras,



Amboseli

Amboseli National Park is famous for its large herds of elephants and the iconic backdrop of Mount Kilimanjaro. It is also renowned for its diverse wildlife, including lions, cheetahs and giraffes.

Tsavo

Tsavo National Park is famous for its Lions population whose adult males often lack manes entirely. As of 2006, there were about 675 lions in the Amboseli-Tsavo ecosystem.



Lake Nakuru

Lake Nakuru National Park is famous for its vast flamingo populations, which can number in the thousands or even millions, and its status as a rhino sanctuary, hosting one of the largest black rhino concentrations in Kenya
